Intensive Day Supervision Program

The Intensive Day Supervision Program is a structured day program. From June 1, 2007 to August 31, 2007, a total of 32 referrals were made to the Program. The Intensive Day Supervision Program focuses on academics, character development, social and behavioral modification. Youth participate in group counseling sessions on substance abuse, healthy lifestyles and anger management. Meals and transportation are provided to all participants.

Time: 8:30am - 10:30am for tutors. Mentor hours are 10:00am to 2:00pm .

Intensive Evening Supervision Program

The Intensive Evening Supervision Program is a program alternative to residential placement. Services are provided to youth between the ages of 10 through 17 years in need of intensive supervision during high risk time periods. From June 1, 2007 to August 31, 2007, a total of 16 referrals were made to the Program. The Intensive Evening Supervision Program focuses on accountability through academics, character development, social and behavioral modification. Tutoring and homework assistance is available. Youth participate in group, educational and cultural activities. Meals and transportation are provided to all participants.

Time: 4:00pm - 6:00pm .
